The Landscape Architectural Accreditation Board (LAAB), at its meeting on June 22, 2026, granted accreditation for a period of six (6) years to the course of study leading to the professional MLA degree at University of Arizona. This status is subject to review of annual reports and maintenance of good standing.

Accreditation is awarded on a time-certain basis. The six-year period of accreditation ends June 30, 2032. Accordingly, the MLA program at University of Arizona is next scheduled for a review during the spring of 2032.
