Preferred Qualifications: One of more of the following: five or more years of teaching experience in accredited landscape architecture program; five or more years of recent professional practice; professional licensure; established area of nationally recognized scholarship and/or authorship of significant professional planning/design works; Ph.D. in landscape architecture or related discipline.
