## Landscape Designer

This position offers a high level of project type diversity and will be most suited for candidates interested in design, analysis and ecology from both environmental and social perspectives. Assisting with all stages of landscape architectural design development, including: participation in the design process and the development of site plans; support developing digital graphic design presentation materials such as rendered site plans, sections, perspectives and diagrams; support developing technical design documentation for construction packages in AutoCAD; modeling design in 3D using Rhino, Grasshopper and Revit. Additionally, this position would support large scale planning and analysis projects through ArcGIS assessments, graphic support, and written content.

- Bachelor or Master's degree in Landscape Architecture from an accredited university
- Landscape architect registration or licensure in U.S., Canada, and/or other countries (for senior position only)
- High level of proficiency in AutoCAD Civil 3D, Adobe Suite, Rhino and Revit programs
- Thorough understanding and knowledge of design, master planning, construction materials, techniques and specifications (for senior position only)

### Preferred Qualifications

- LEED accreditation is preferred, but not required
- Proficiency in ArcGIS is preferred, but not required
- Some proficiency in Spanish and/or French
