

## LANDSCAPE ARCHITECTURE SHORT AD

The WSU Landscape Architecture Program, School of Design and Construction, College of Engineering, Washington State University in Pullman, WA invites applications for a permanent, full-time, tenure-track 9-month academic appointment position as Assistant Professor to begin on August 16, 2018. The WSU Landscape Architecture Program values the holistic approaches required to address the substantive challenges of society, notably climate change, human health, food production, urbanization, and water use. We are particularly interested in candidates who seek to explore and enliven design education; find opportunity in the complexity and overlap of ecological, social, aesthetic, and professional issues; and who can move fluidly among the multiple facets of landscape architecture practice. The successful candidate will teach the conventions and potential of contemporary landscape design practice in studio and classroom-based settings, teach a minimum of four courses per year including required and elective courses across multiple disciplines (Landscape Architecture, Interior Design, and Architecture) within the School, advance a program of research and/or creative scholarship, and make service contributions to the School, University, and state. S/he will also contribute to the development of the Landscape Architecture Program and an established culture of integration and collaboration among the allied disciplines within the School.

Qualifications: Professional Master's Degree in Landscape Architecture (MLA), or a Master's or PhD degree in a related field and a professional Bachelor's of Landscape Architecture degree (BLA or BSLA) by employment start date; demonstrated knowledge of contemporary and emerging digital landscape visualization and representation techniques and an ability to apply and integrate this knowledge in studio settings, and across disciplines; established or promising program of creative scholarship/research.
