Under limited direction, performs and oversees complex park planning projects that are multi-division, multi-faceted and multi-agency, and high profile in nature. Independently plans and conducts public processes related to specialized projects with high importance to the Park Authority. Independently represents the agency in a professional capacity at Boards, Authorities, and Commissions and serves as an internal consultant and agency expert on long range park system planning, strategic planning, park master planning, and public engagement. Plans, directs, supervises, and mentors a section of planning and technical professionals to carry out assigned projects including preparation of routine and complex park master plans and conceptual designs, development of regional park plans, conducting demographic research and data collection and analysis, and planning of public engagement efforts. Resolves priority conflicts and coordinates tasks and projects. This position does supervise other full and part-time employees.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS:

Any combination of education, experience, and training equivalent to the following: graduation from an accredited four-year college or university in a planning-related field; plus five years of experience in a specific area of assignment or concentration, including, but not limited to, multi-layered, cross-agency zoning application evaluation, environmental policy, historic preservation, housing policy, public facility policy, and/or land use policy and implementation. A master's degree may be substituted for one year of the required experience.

NECESSARY SPECIAL REQUIREMENTS:

- Appointee must complete a criminal background check and a driving record check to the satisfaction of the employer.

PREFERRED QUALIFICATIONS:

- Master's degree in a planning-related field (urban planning, environmental planning, landscape architecture);
- Five years of experience as a senior planner;
- Experience working with cross-agency, multi-disciplinary teams;
- Experience supervising, training, and/or mentoring others in planning work;
- Excellent project management skills as demonstrated by successful completion of park master plans and/or major planning studies;
- American Institute of Certified Planners (AICP) certification and/or professional Landscape Architect's license.

PHYSICAL REQUIREMENTS:

Job is generally sedentary in nature, however, visual acuity is required to read data on computer monitor. Incumbent must also be able to operate keyboard driven equipment, communicate with others, and have the ability to conduct site visits on uneven and natural terrain. Employee may be required to lift up to 15 pounds. Duties can be performed with or without reasonable accommodations.
