The ideal candidate will join our Salem based team in the execution of planning and design tasks for recreation enhancement projects throughout the state. The primary purpose of this position is to work directly with the Planning + Design Manager, Planning + Design team members and OPRD's field managers to plan, design and develop recreation facilities that better serve Oregon's citizens and visitors. The ideal candidate must be a licensed Landscape Architect in the State of Oregon or be able to secure an LA license within 6 months of employment with Oregon State Parks.

Our new Senior Planner will focus on providing project team leadership and project management for the development of new park master plans and the update of existing plans. Secondary duties will include developing plans, budgets and specifications for park and trail enhancements throughout the park system.

The Planning + Design team works collaboratively with our engineering and stewardship sections along with our field managers to visualize recreation improvement design solutions that are responsive to the public needs. Recreation facility needs are established through frequent public engagement efforts in coordination with the Statewide Comprehensive Outdoor Recreation Plan, the Oregon Trails Plan and other recreation development guiding documents.
