

City of Palm Coast, FL – Landscape Architect or Landscape Architect in Training

The City is seeking a Landscape Architect or a Landscape Architect in Training who will understand and administer land use regulations, codes and ordinances relating to landscape/irrigation and tree preservation for the planning and development of the City. The City already has a well-seasoned registered landscape architect but desires to add an additional landscape architect position due to growth in the City and since the City does their own landscaping/irrigation design work for numerous City capital projects.

Palm Coast is a newer, fast growing city of about 77,000 people in Northeast Florida nestled between St. Augustine and Daytona Beach and is situated along numerous canals, the Intracoastal Waterway and nearby pristine Atlantic Ocean beaches. Much of Palm Coast's growth is attributed to very well landscaped roadways and multi-purpose trails, numerous parks, lack of traffic jams, and reasonable-priced housing. The City's respect for the environment continues to be recognized as the City is designated a *Tree City USA* and a *Florida Green City-Gold Standard* by the Florida Green Building Coalition.

Successful performance of the Landscape Architect position will require extensive professional technical background as well as skills in reviewing and processing site plans, tree surveys, and landscape/irrigation plans to determine their compliance with City and other applicable regulations. Landscape and irrigation design and implementation of City capital improvement projects. Duties include field reviews, inspections, and overseeing the installation of trees and plants. Position works closely with outside design professionals, landscape contractors and other City staff members.

Requirements for the Landscape Architect position include: Bachelor's Degree in Landscape Architecture or related field; supplemented by four (4) years professional landscape architect experience (two years for those with a Master's Degree in Landscape Architecture); or an equivalent combination of education, training, and experience; and preference is for a Registered Landscape Architect. Requirements for the Landscape Architect in Training include: Bachelor's or Master's Degree in Landscape Architecture or related field. Requires valid State of Florida driver's license.
